1. Old Business:

Review Town Manager actions on recommendations from last meeting

- A. Request to identify all school zones in town and ensure they are appropriately listed in the Traffic Rules and Orders. **TAC: The TAC recommends that we approve all the school zones identified by Engineering with the exception of the High school. The High school should be identified as a "Safety Zone" as outlined in the MUTCD and Mass. Amendments to the MUTCD. Please see attached memo from Engineering**
- B. Request to add two speed bumps/tables to Carl Landi Cir. **TAC: Not recommended. The TAC recommends speed enforcement and data collection.**

2. New Business:

- A. Request for No Parking signage along Gifford St. outside the entrance to Goodwill Park.
- B. Request for temporary "Trucks entering and exiting" signage at Brick Kiln Rd. and Homestead Ln.
- C. Request to discuss illegal parking concerns on Grand Ave. in the vicinity of the Black Dog Café

- D. Request to discuss possible parking solutions on Austin Stokes Rd. Request made on behalf of the neighborhood association.
- E. Request for tree/shrub trimming on the South side of the Backus River Rd. / Old Barnstable Rd. intersection
- F. Request for a crosswalk to the beach in the vicinity of 121 Pinecrest Beach Dr. Also requested beach signage and no parking signage in the vicinity of this residence.
- G. Request "Stop bars" be painted at both exits of Eel River Rd.
- H. Request to add an "Emergency Vehicle only" parking spot at Quissett Harbor / The Knob.
- I. Contractor requests to paint a crosswalk across Trotting Park Road with ADA Tactile Strips on either side at 637 Gifford Street (40B). The Engineering Department will handle the permitting process.
- J. Request to discuss traffic calming measures on Quaker Rd. in the vicinity of Krikor Dr. Residents are concerned crossing Quaker Rd. to access the sidewalk.
