

**Falmouth Recreation Committee Meeting CORRECTED MINUTES**

Open Meeting

At 4:36 Bob Brown opened the meeting.

Nominate, discuss and vote Community Preservation Recreation Department Representative  
Bob Brown explained that his term as representative will expire on 6/30/19.

**Sandy Cuny moved to nominate Bob Brown Community Preservation Recreation Department Representative. Scott Ghelfi seconded. All in favor; motion passed.**

Bob Brown explained that this would be subject to his reappointment to the Recreation Committee. He noted that he would advocate for active and passive recreation projects but that there has been community pressure from the CPC to act on affordable housing needs as this is a crisis in Falmouth.

Concern was expressed that new projects put pressure on the maintenance budget after the projects have been completed. The committee should voice concerns regarding maintenance and whether there is enough staff to do adequate maintenance. Bob Brown will draft a report and request 10 minutes on the Board of Selectmen agenda.

A suggestion was made to rate the fields to see what progress was made every year. The ratings could be linked to the Gayle report.
