The Planning Board shall be responsible for the development and periodic updating of a Master Plan or portions thereof. Such plan may include all or portions of plans developed by other boards or committees but these inclusions must receive a vote of approval by the Planning Board. Plans approved by the Local Comprehensive Planning Committee must receive a vote of approval from the Planning Board before submission to Town Meeting and then the Cape Cod Commission.

Amendment to Article V - The Town Administrator

The Assistant Town Administrator shall act as the Town Administrator during the absence of the Town Administrator of not more than ninety (90) days and, with the approval of the Board of Selectmen, for an additional period of ninety (90) days.

In the event of a vacancy in the office of Town Administrator caused by the suspension, removal, resignation or death of the temporary absense of both the Town Administrator and the Assistant Town Administrator, the Board of Selectmen shall designate, within ten (10) days of any such event, a town employee or other person to exercise the powers and perform the duties of the Town Administrator. This designation shall be for a period not to exceed ninety(90) days, and it may be renewed, only once, for an additional period not to exceed ninety (90) days. Members of the Board of Selectmen shall be ineligible to serve in this capacity. The designation shall be made by a vote at a duly noticed oen meeting and a copy shall be filled with the Town Clerk.
