This course will help with your preparation in becoming a successful candidate for the position of Municipal Police based on the state-wide examination. Becoming a successful candidate is based solely on your examination score. Therefore it is absolutely necessary to be a high ranking applicant in order to be considered for selection. This course will also help you obtain the competitive edge- we will discuss the NEW examination format consisting of three subtests made up of cognitive and non-cognitive questions: the six "ability areas" of the written ability test (WAT), the Life Experience Survey (LES), and the Work Style Questionnaire (WSQ). The LES and the WSQ are part of the NEW testing format containing a number of non-cognitive questions known as "**psychometric questions**". This will be part of our presentation since many Massachusetts candidates have never been subjected to this type of testing.
